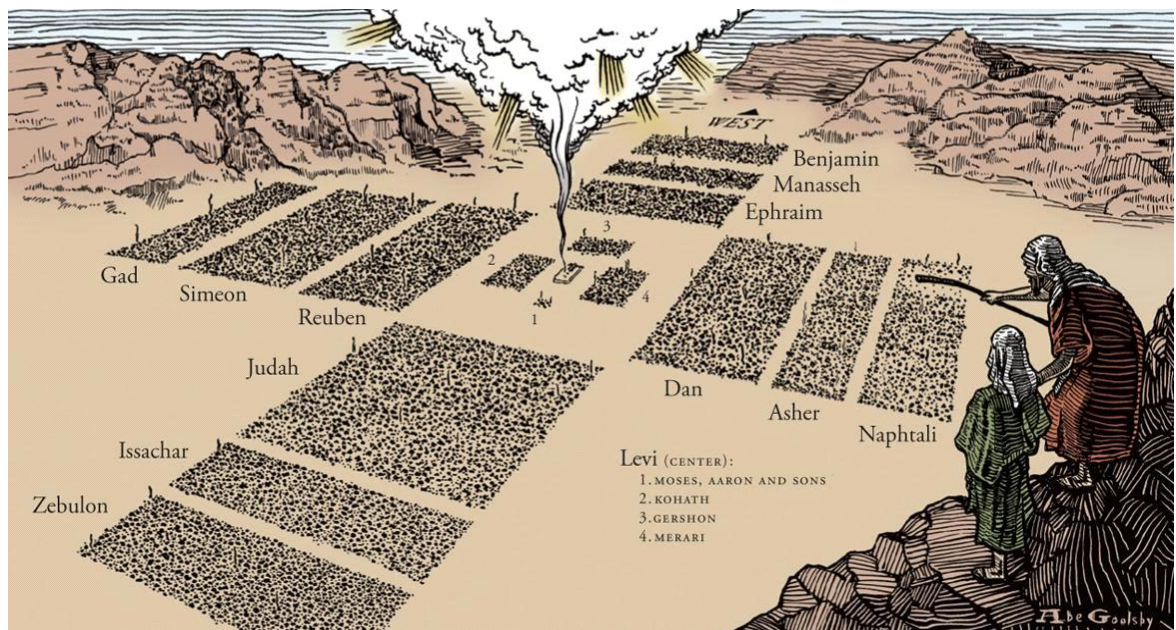
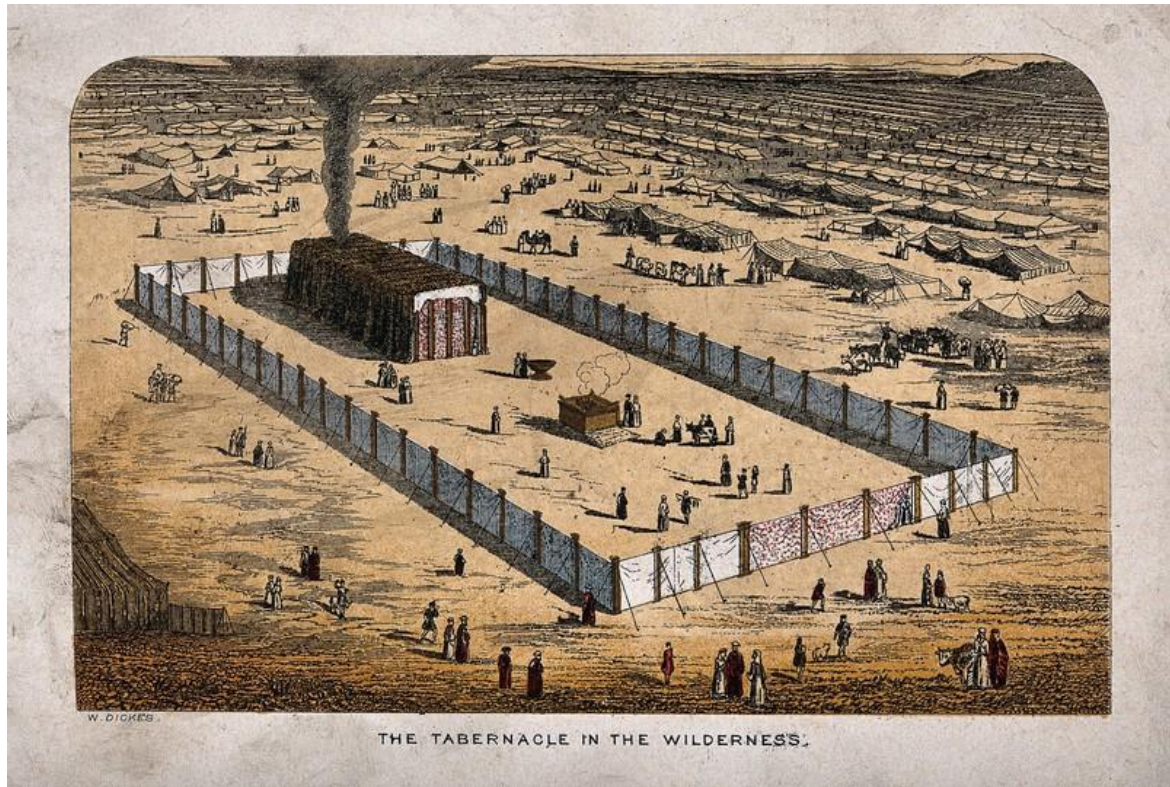


THE TABERNACLE

INTRODUCTION

1 Peter 1:18-20 Revelation 13:8	The sacrifice of Jesus on the cross was planned by God from the beginning of creation
John 5:46	Jesus says the prophet Moses wrote of Him
Matthew 5:17	Jesus came to fulfil the plan of God revealed through the law (of Moses) and the prophets.
Hebrews 9:1-9	The Tabernacle was not the way of salvation but was a pattern of the way.
Acts 15:13-18	'build again' So it was a pattern of how to worship God – come into his presence – salvation.
Exodus 25: 8 & 21-22	That I may dwell among them.
Hebrews 8 : 1-6	Shadow of heavenly things.

Old Testament	Two principle covenants: Abraham – faith Moses – law
New Testament	Jesus – fulfilled the covenants of faith and law
Matthew 5:17 John 5:46 John 14:6 Galatians 3:24	<p>... to fulfil the law and the prophets ... Moses wrote of Jesus ... I am the way ... the law is a schoolmaster to bring us to Christ</p> <p>The law was the revelation of God to Moses and the history of His dealings with Israel and is contained in the first 5 books of the Bible: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy. It was intended to teach through God's physical laws everything that was to be fulfilled in Jesus Christ.</p>
